Dear Parents and Carers

Robin class have the opportunity to have swimming lessons with a qualified instructor at the Billericay First Strokes pool.

The pupils will swim every Monday starting 11<sup>th</sup> September. **The last swimming session will be Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December** (there will be no lessons on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October as this is half term or on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> November as this is a non pupil day).

The cost of this lesson is £5.80 a week or £63.80 in total.

Our preferred method of payment is by SIMS Agora and we would encourage you to make payments online if at all possible. By using SIMS Agora you will be able to track all the credits you make to school so that you can keep an exact account of where you are with payments. Alternatively, for those parents and carers who do not choose to use the on-line facility, please contact the school for a Paypoint barcode. Cash and cheque payments are also accepted.

Your child will need a named swimming costume/shorts, towel and a swimming hat. If you do not already have a swimming hat they can be purchased from Billericay First Strokes for £6. If you would like to buy one of these swimming hats please send in the money in a labelled envelope on Monday.

Swimming is a valuable part of our curriculum, not only developing physical strength and co-ordination but also promoting well-being and independence skills.
