

Coronavirus (COVID-19): home test kits

Thriftwood School & College have been given a supply of COVID-19 home test kits. Government guidance is that these kits should only be offered to individuals in exceptional circumstances, where they may have barriers to accessing testing elsewhere.

- 1. We will **only** offer kits to students and staff when:
 - They display symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19). These symptoms are a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, or a loss or change to the individual's sense of smell or taste. Tests will **not** be given to pupils or staff who are not displaying one or more of these symptoms.
 - There are barriers to getting a test at a local test centre. These barriers include ability to access transport, individual special educational needs of the child or vulnerability of child / family.
- 2. Schools will not administer the tests this must be done by parents / carers in the home setting.
- 3. Tests will not be offered to family members only students and staff of Thriftwood School and College.
- 4. Full instructions on how to administer the test and what to do next are provided within each kit.
- 5. A child / staff member will only be able to return to school / work when they have received confirmation of a negative test result
- 6. Should the test be positive, the school should be immediately informed and the individual should self-isolate for 10 days.
