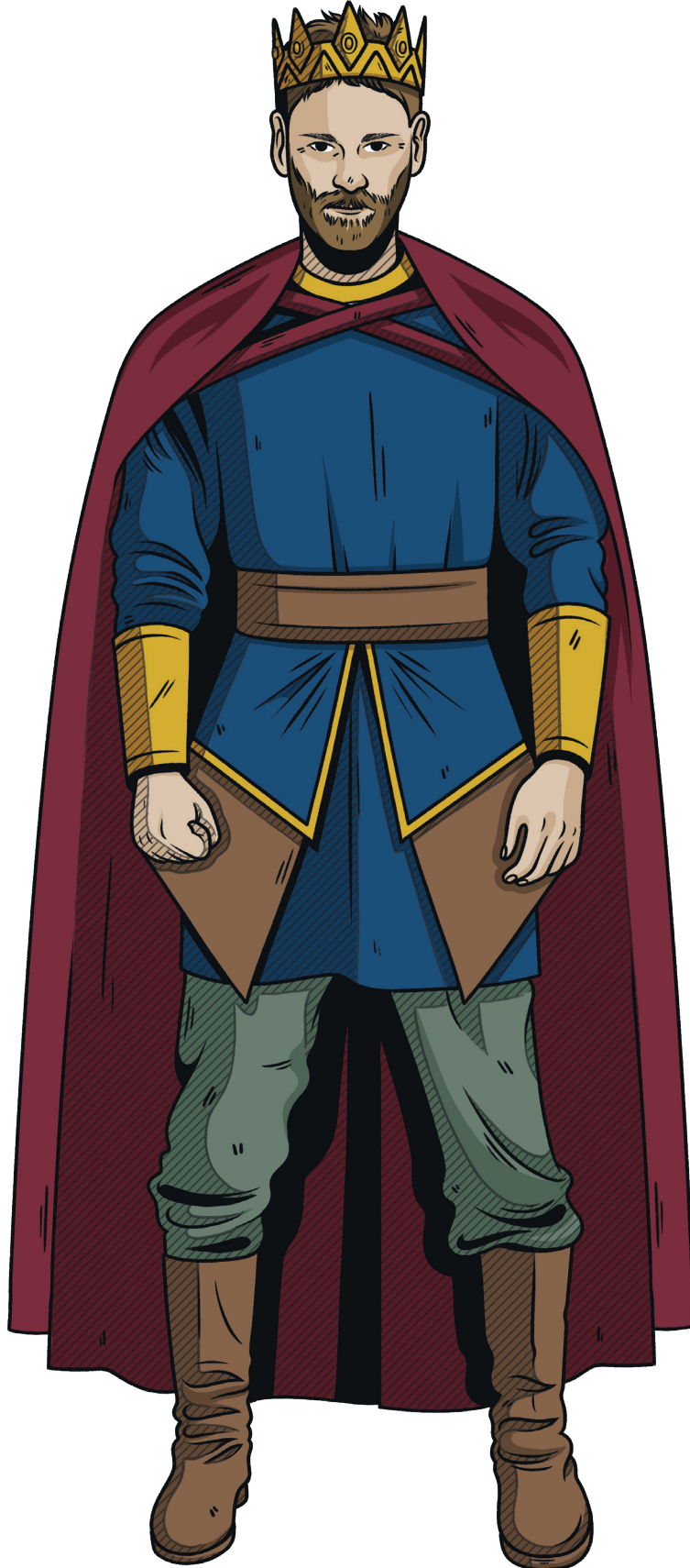


Macbeth Character Descriptions

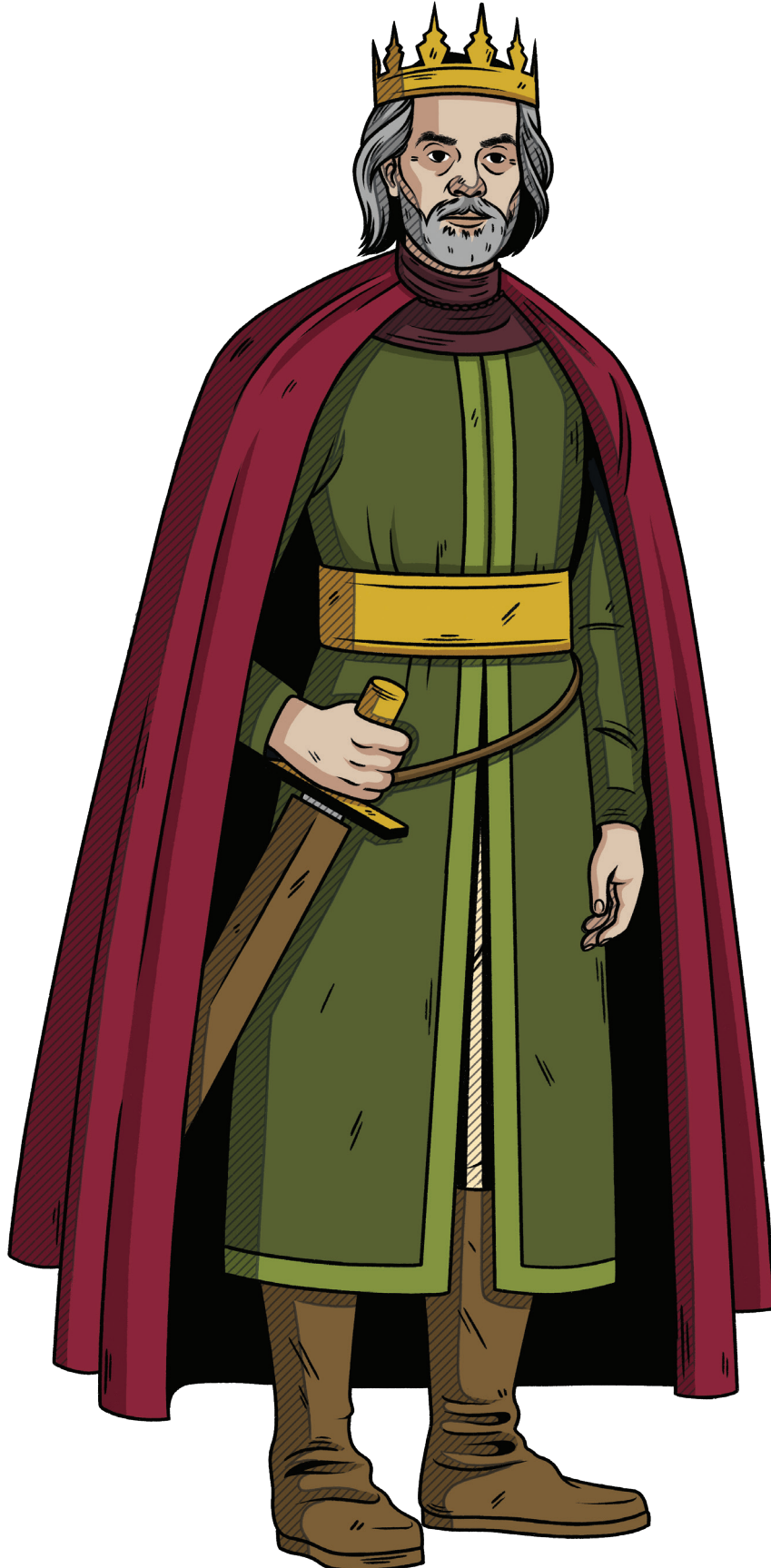
Macbeth

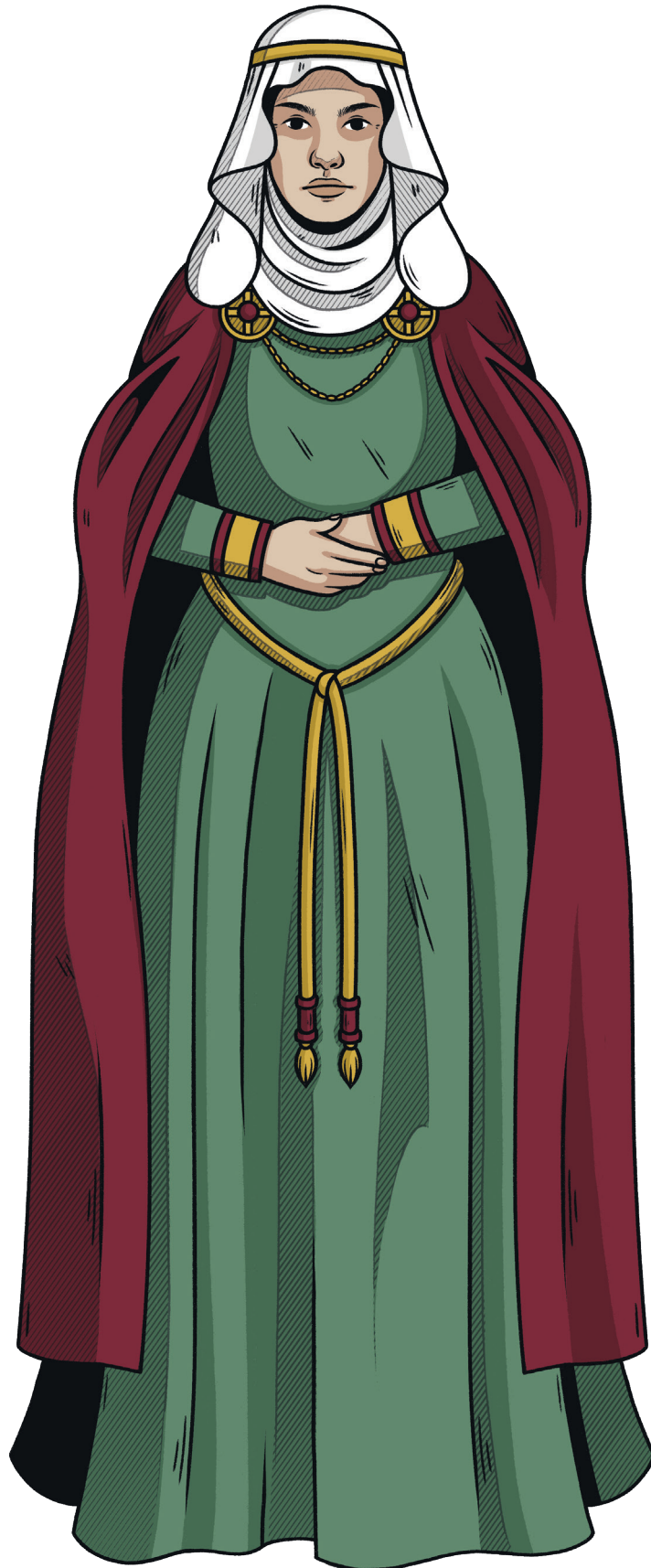
Duncan

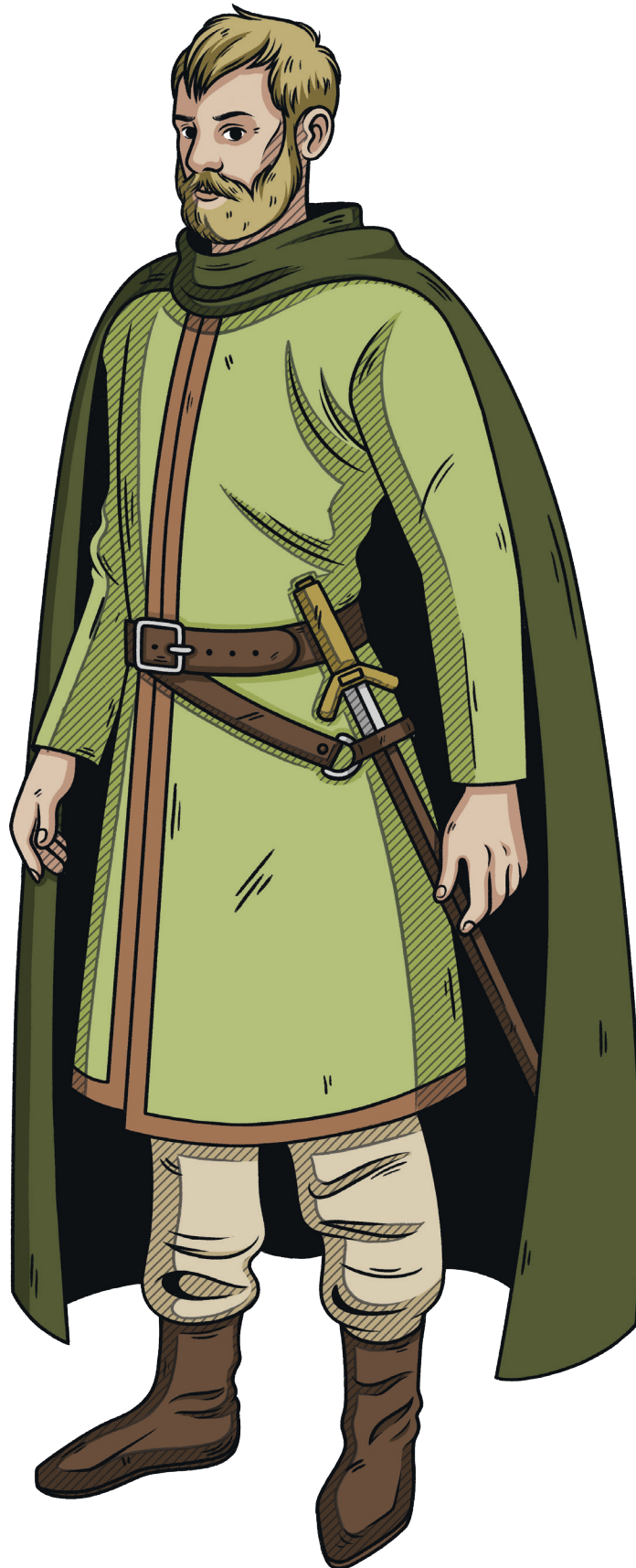
Lady Macbeth

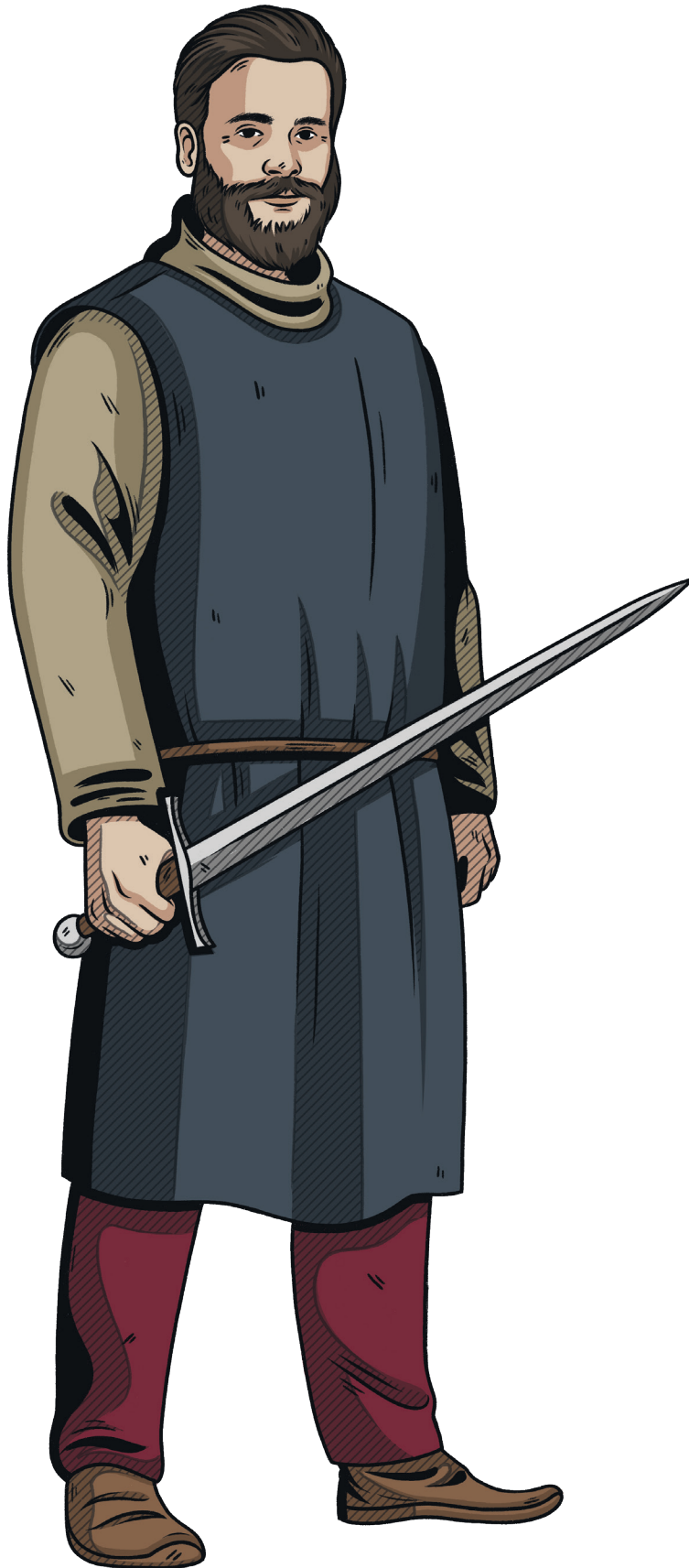
Banquo

Banquo is in Duncan's army and he is good friends with Macbeth. He is a brave soldier. The witches say that his son, Fleance, will become king. He dies courageously.



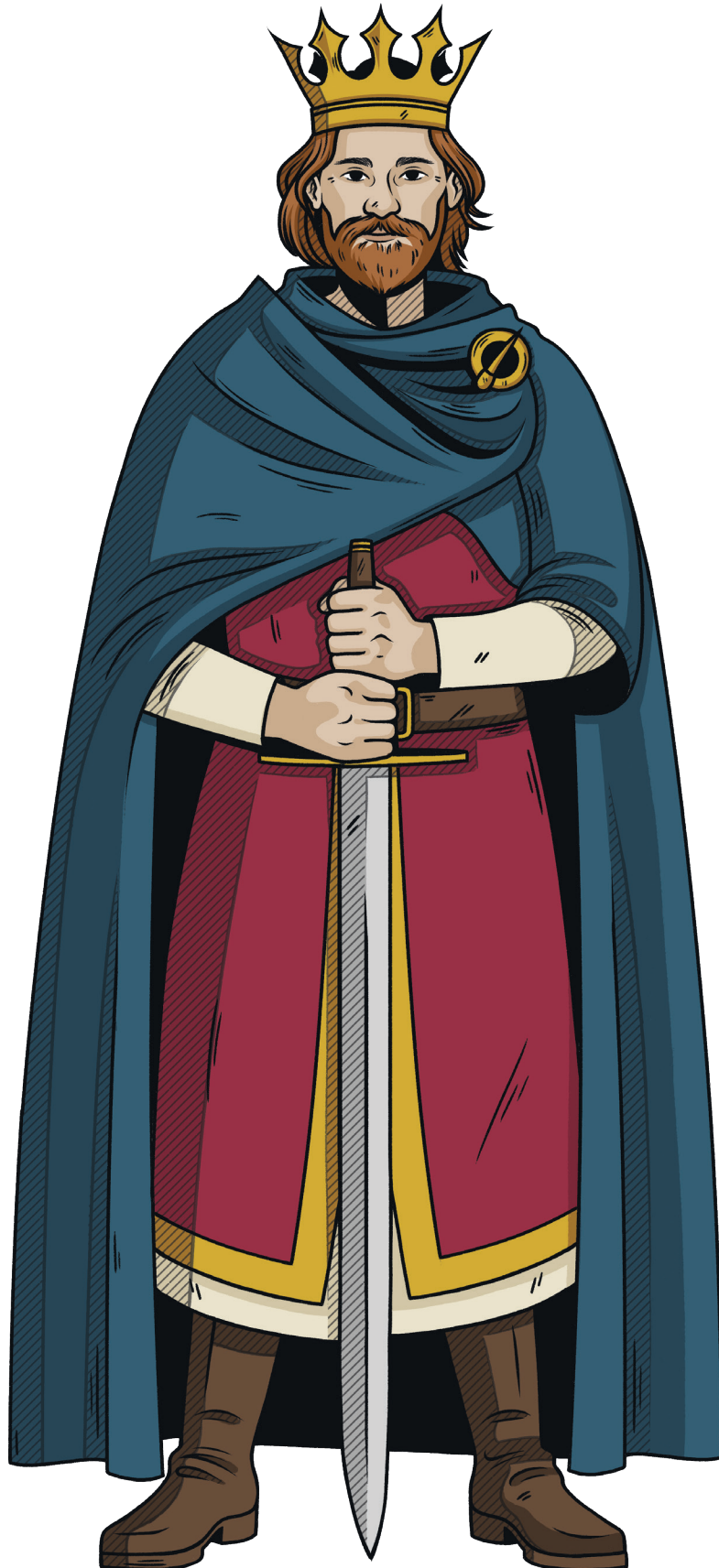
Macduff
