## Topic

We will look at the countries around the world and where food comes from. We will explore and taste different world foods and look at special foods for special days in different religions. We will also explore where food is grown and how it gets to our plate as well as looking at balanced diets. Our art will link to our theme, using foods to explore different media including Digital media, shades and tones and using natural colours of foods and spices to create art.

Our knowledge and understanding of foods will be applied in Food tech lessons each week.

## Fundamentals For Future (FFF) - Life skills

We will be focusing specifically on our FFF in Life skills lessons on Monday morning. Our focus will be spent on road safety, using money and looking after the community. For some children this will involve role play and developing the skills on school site and for some we may practise these off site too visiting different local places including shops, parks, cafes.

## PSHE

This term focus on a number of areas looking after ourselves.  
We look at:-

Keeping clean and healthy and Staying Safe  
Body Changes and Growing

Relationships and Sex Education Yr 5 and 6. You will have received a letter regarding what to expect for those children in year 5 and 6.

## Maths

The areas being covered in maths this term are:-

Place value (including Money)

The four operations (+ - x ÷)

Real life measure; length and weight

We will link these skills to opportunities to applying them to real life situations

## English

Each class will be using a text as the basis for their English reading and writing:-

Swan: The Hungry Caterpillar

Robin: Handa's Surprise

Puffin and Kingfisher - Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

Reading will develop their comprehension skills and writing will focus on story writing and non fiction genres including:

Lists, Recipes, Food labels, Instructions. These lessons will also link closely with our Food technology lessons

We continue with our phonics program, working on a sound per week. This is put on Tapestry for you to see each week.

## Science

Growing and looking after our own crops, including foods such as potatoes, strawberries.

We will look at types of plants and explore what they need to grow. We will also look at how a plant reproduces. Watch out for our Sunflower growing competition on Tapestry!
