Needed to be progressive, aspirational, and underpins all our other curricula




Predominantly skills-based and enables our students to be independent, confident and healthy



The Intent

- To bring together how School and College assess and monitor Personal and Social Development
- To cherry-pick a range of skills relevant to ALL students (school and college) and level them from 1 to 5
- To organise the 324 skills into the Preparation for **Adulthood titles**
- To design a bespoke assessment system that allows all staff to assess students against these skills and produce a comprehensive report on their progress.

Built an assessment system around this framework and launch it within the school site.

Phase leaders and SLT across school and college selected skills and organised them into headings.



Whole staff sessions dedicated to unpicking PIVATS and PLTS to find common threads and add skills specific to our students.






The Impact
