



In the first half term, each class will be learning to read and recognise rhyme and to describe settings or characters from space themed stories.

Kingfisher class will read 'The Smeds and Smoos' and 'The Way Back Home'
In the second half term, we will be using our new Topic knowledge to write basic non-fiction texts about space. This will include labelling, reading and writing facts as well as creating posters or fact files.
