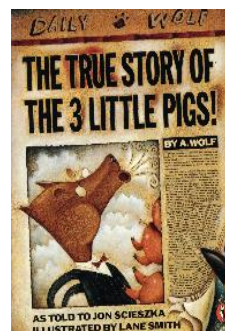
P.E - Athletics focus on running, jumping, and throwing.
