The date can be written in several different ways, combining numbers and words or just using numbers. For example, the 20th of April 2014 can also be written as:

20/04/14, 20 April 2014 or 20 Apr 14.

The months of the year are sometimes written in a short form, or abbreviation. This may be written as letters or numbers. This table shows you how the months can be abbreviated.
