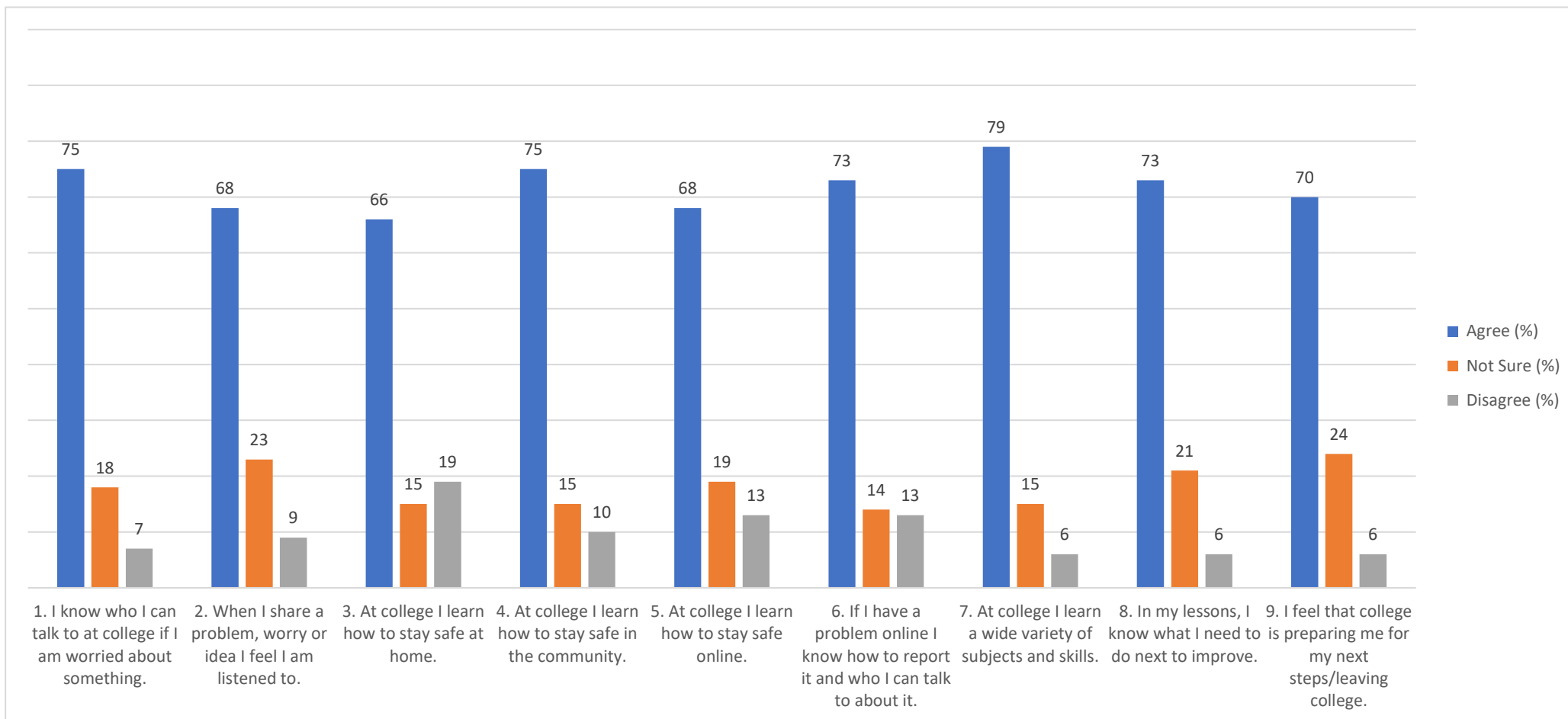


## Student Survey Analysis

In summary, the analysis of the survey data reveals that the majority of students generally agree with the statements provided. For instance, the highest agreement was observed in Q7. *At college I learn a wide variety of subjects and skills* (79%) while the lowest was in Q3. *At college I learn how to stay safe at home* (66%). Notably, Q3 also had the highest level of disagreement (19%). Respondents were mostly undecided in Q9. *I feel that college is preparing me for my next steps/leaving college*, with 24% selecting "Not Sure." Overall, the findings suggest that most participants hold favourable views towards the topics addressed in the survey, although some uncertainty and disagreement remain in certain areas.



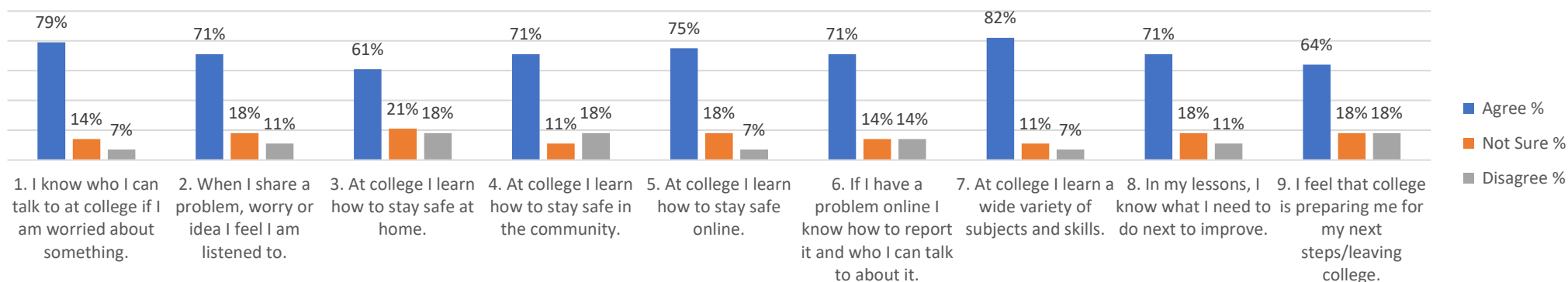
Upon analysing the data, the tutor group with the most negative responses across both Key Stages is 12RR. Many students in this group provided "Disagree" or "Not Sure" responses to various questions, indicating that they may not be as satisfied with their college experience compared to students in other tutor groups.

The tutor group with the most positive responses across both Key Stages is 13EW. The majority of students in this group provided "Agree" responses to various questions, indicating a higher level of satisfaction with their college experience compared to students in other tutor groups.

### Key Stage 4



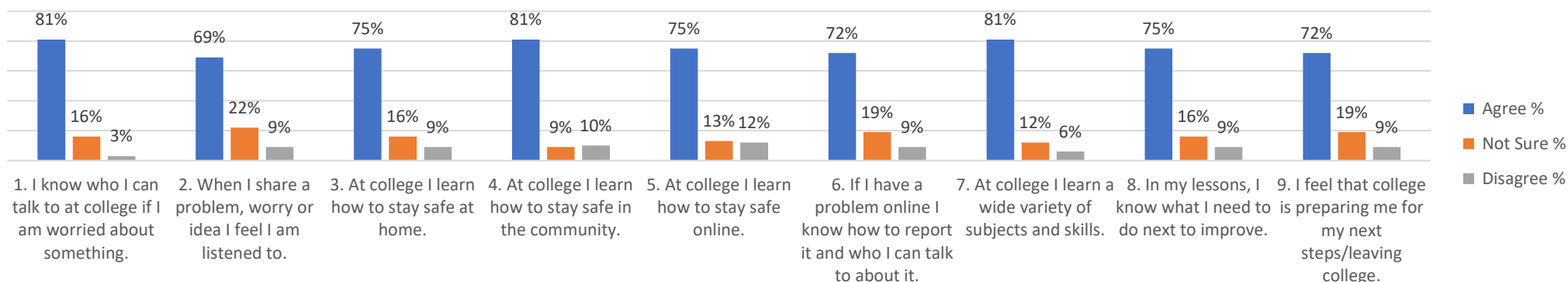
#### Enjoy most about college:
