



Do you receive an appropriate level of communication from the school via text, email, paper letters, notes in home school diaries, phone calls and information on the website?




Do you feel that you are kept well informed about your child's academic and social progress?




Do you feel that Thriftwood provides a broad curriculum offer, including community visits, life skills and functional English and maths for your child?




Do you feel that your child receives a good level of support for their personal development and wellbeing?



Do you access Tapestry at home?




If you access Tapestry, is it useful in finding out what your child is doing at school?
