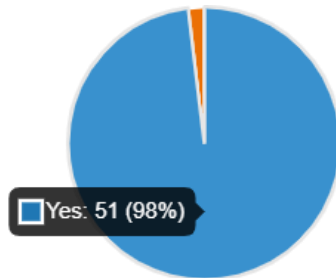
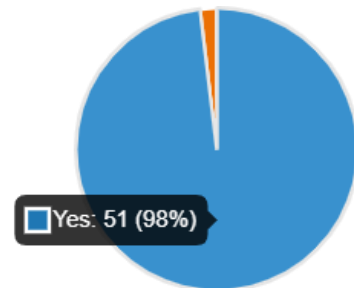


Thriftwood School Parents Survey Results November 2022

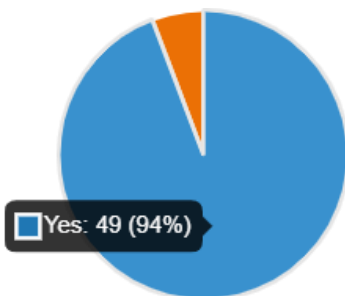
Do you receive an appropriate level of communication from the school via text, email, paper letters, notes in home school diaries, phone calls and information on the website?



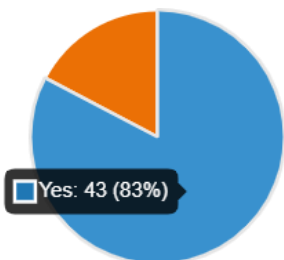
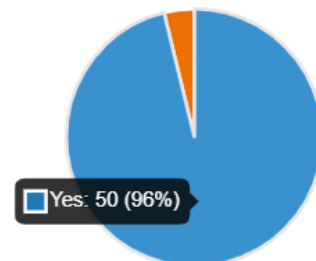
Does your child feel happy and safe in school?

Do we provide enough opportunities for you to come into school?



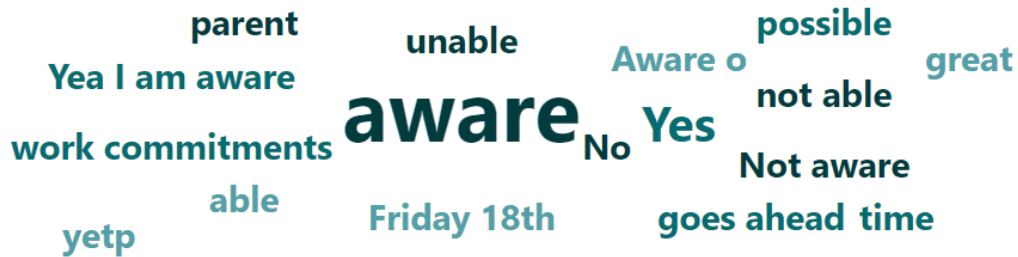
We aim to provide a high level of social, emotional and pastoral support for all our pupils, are you aware that this is provided for our students?

Are you aware of, or have attended, the parents' coffee support meetings?

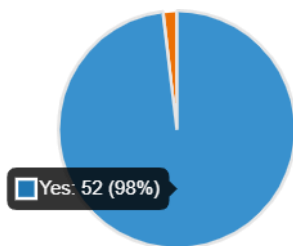

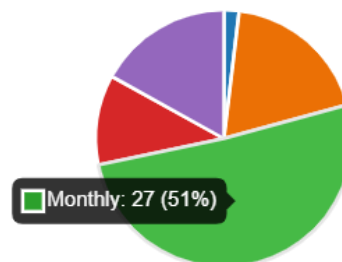


Do you feel that Thriftwood provides a broad curriculum offer, including community visits, life skills and functional English and maths for our pupils?

 - Sometimes communications is hard to follow, different mobile numbers. Are these events published on the website for parents to access only. Trips etc, school menus as i struggling to keep on top or access this information without having to check my text messages emails and asking staff to print off information to be sent home
- It would be helpful if the school could ask for an amount of money each half term to cover for trips etc. rather than adhoc weekly requests for parents to try and remember. Text messages with key information really good. My experience to date has been excellent thank you.
